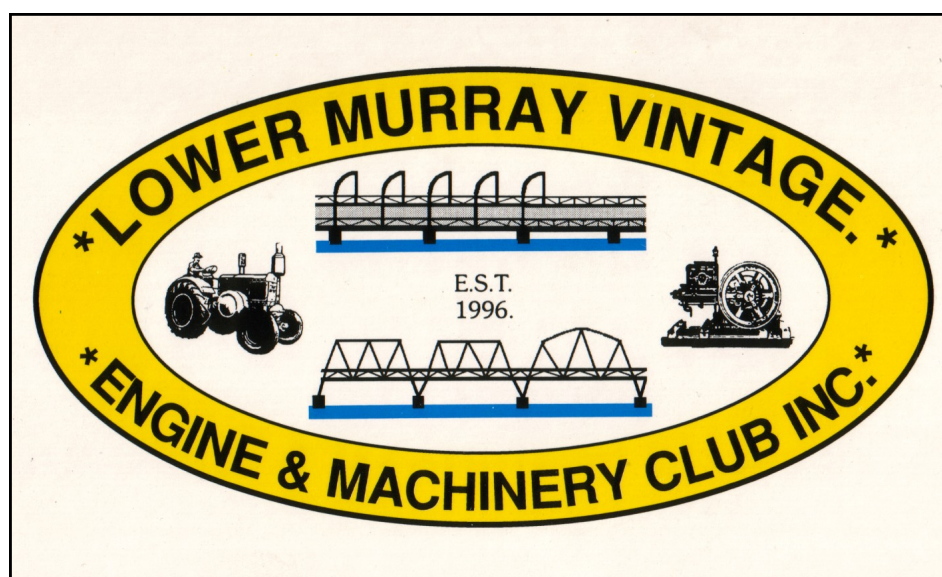

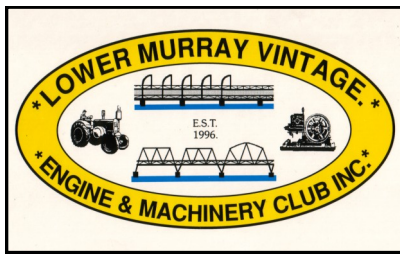

I can not really remember Father Christmas bringing me my pedal car in about 1943 I would have been three years old at the time but I have a lot of great memories of using it. Once driving it in the cow shed I got too close to the back of a cow and it lashed out and tipped me out.

The side was all pushed in and I was given a lecture on not being in the cow shed while blowing the horn.

I used to take down to the road from our house waiting for one of the many trucks coming in our yard the drivers would tie a rope onto the back and tow me up past the house to the shed Where I could easily pedal back down the hill to the house.

I built a boring rig on it, which was fitted for many years to bore for water in the garden, While doing this one day I found some old coins including a half sovereign which I kept for many years and I think it was finally stolen when we had a house break at Tollcross.

Over the year's dad had to rebuild the seat and it had two sets of new wheels.

My children and a lot of others all played with it over the years. Then I was asked to use it for a series of Television commercials, which were filmed in Adelaide. This made it quite well known, everyone that I spoke to new the little red car on TV

In 1997 I felt it was well over fifty years old and deserved a rebuild so I decided to completely rebuild it, How ever the further I went the more it involved it got.

Having to make a new bonnet, seat and tray then have new wheels and head lights etc., It ended costing in the area of \$1000.00

It was finally finished just before my dead line the year 2000 for some of my grandchildren to try out before they got too big for it.

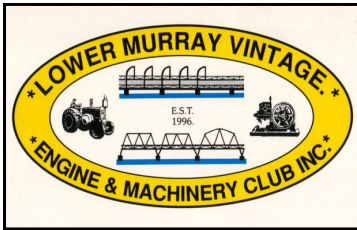
